


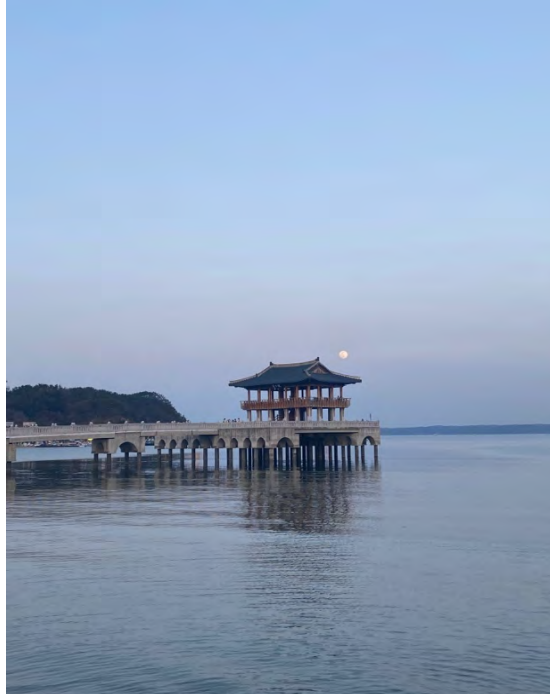
LIFE IN HGU

| <u>Health Insurance</u> | <p>All International students must have a Korean government insurance to cover the costs of treatment for injury and sickness in Korea. (Not a way of reimbursement, but a way of reduction of the medical fee, as Korean citizenship). For the reimbursement of medical fee, students will have a private health insurance either made in Korea or in home countries.</p> | | | | | | | | | | | | | | | | | | | | | | | | | | | | | | |

Pohang, where HGU is located, is known as a seaside city and a high-tech based industrial city that is home to the 4th largest steel-making company, POSCO. *Gyeongju*, a UNESCO-designated historic city, is within a 40-minute drive from HGU. Other major cities, such as Seoul, Busan, and Daegu, are easily accessible by transportation (30 min.~2.5hours).
