Tuition fee	Tuition fee and admission fee shall be waived for <b>exchange students</b> .		
	International students but not exchange students shall pay the same tuition		
	fee and admission fee as normal HUFLIT students.		
	The admission fee is \$28, while the tuition fee is counted by credits with		
	\$40 - \$60/credit.		
Textbooks	\$25 - \$50/ semester (estimated)		
Food	\$1.5 - \$3/ casual meal (estimated)		
Accommodation	- Exchange students shall be supported in finding suitable		
	accommodation nearby the campus (\$200 - \$250 /month) including:		
	bed, internet, private bathroom, air conditioner and refrigerator.		
	- Students should stay in a hotel during the time finding suitable rental		
	rooms/apartments.		
	- Students are recommended to find the accommodation themselves,		
	but should report the address of the accommodation to the International		
	relations coordinator of HUFLIT in order to be supported and protected		
	if necessary.		
	- If students find the accommodation themselves, always remember to		
	make <u>a contract</u> with the owner. Then, a deposit of 1 month is usually		
	required by the owner.
