



## EPICUR Students' Event 8th of October 2020 (on-line)

We would like to invite you to participate in the First Student's Conference which will be held on the October 8th 2020. The Conference will be taking place virtually via MS Teams and will be broadcasted on YouTube (<https://youtu.be/9NCA97aq7xg>). It is addressed to students following the path and vision of Tomorrow's Universities. The topic of the Conference is, of course, very relevant for EPICUR goals. During the discussions of the working group on student affairs, as well as during all the meetings with students so far, the issue of students' involvement in the EPICUR project was repeatedly raised. To meet these expectations, we would like to dedicate our virtual meeting to the presentation prepared by the student teams.

To facilitate the exchange of information, we suggest that the presentations should consist of three parts: 1) brief information about home university (facts and figures), 2) manifestations of student life (organizations, unions, clubs, etc.), 3) possible, proposed or currently implemented forms of student involvement in the realization of the EPICUR mission and objectives of the EPICUR project at local level.

The exchange of experiences of representatives of all universities will allow us to create a platform for cooperation at the consortium level. We hope that students who will join the event, will be interested, first of all, to get involved in the EPICUR project at local level in the long term.

EPICUR, the European Partnership for an Innovative Campus Unifying Regions, is a first-generation European university alliance, dedicated to shaping a sustainable, peaceful and healthy European future through the development of collaborative interdisciplinary and transdisciplinary teaching and research.
