

**Criteria for awarding points for scientific achievements in the recruitment procedure  
to the Doctoral School of Social Sciences  
in the discipline of Political science and administration  
in the academic year 2024/2025**

<b>Grade entered in the graduation diploma of second cycle studies or uniform master's studies:</b>	<b>max 10 points</b>
• very good	10 points
• good plus	8 points
• good	6 points
• satisfactory plus	3 points
• satisfactory	1 point
<b>Scientific achievement (points awarded for up to three supporting documents):<sup>1</sup></b>	<b>max 15 points</b>
• Scientific publications in scientific journals, collective works and journals of scientific associations - only published (texts required or copies of texts to be supplied with the ISBN number)	5 points for each publication
• Scientific conferences with papers, communications, posters	3 points for each conference
<b>Other achievements (points awarded for up to three documented achievements):<sup>1</sup></b>	<b>max 5 points</b>
• Participation in the student research movement	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- one achievement = 1 point</li> <li>- two achievements = 3 points</li> <li>- three achievements = 5 points</li> </ul>
• National and international placements (exchange programs, e.g. MOST, LLP-Erasmus, other scholarships, internships related to the major or path pursued - does not apply to obligatory student internships included in the study plan and curriculum)	
• Awards and distinctions for academic achievements and student activities	
• Knowledge of foreign languages (required certificates or certificates of language courses to be submitted for inspection)	
<b>Evaluation of the interview</b>	<b>max 50 points</b>
• Candidate's knowledge and competencies relevant to the research to be undertaken and appropriate to the discipline indicated	max 25 points
• Knowledge of the elements of research methodology appropriate to the discipline indicated	max 25 points

<sup>1</sup> If a candidate demonstrates scholarly activity other than that covered by the above list, points will be awarded based on the agreement of all members of the Selection Committee.

<b>Evaluation of the research project</b>	<b>max 20 points</b>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ability to formulate the research objective and present the research problem</li> </ul>	max 5 points
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Evaluation of the research idea and ability to propose a solution</li> </ul>	max 5 points
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Evaluation of the methodology appropriate to the indicated discipline</li> </ul>	max 5 points
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Knowledge of the state of the art in research, together with basic bibliography relevant to the indicated aims</li> </ul>	max 5 points
