Rules of awarding points in the admission procedure to the Doctoral School
in the discipline of *socio-economic geography and spatial planning*

Acting on the basis of Resolution No. 65/2020/2021 of the Senate of the Adam Mickiewicz University in Poznań of 25 January 2021 on the rules of admission to doctoral schools of Adam Mickiewicz University in Poznań in the academic year 2021/2022, the following rules are established for awarding points in the admission procedure:

A grade from a diploma of master's studies or a diploma of uniform master's studies. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Very good - 10 points• Good plus - 6 points• Good - 2 points• Satisfactory plus and lower - 0 points	0-10
Assessment of the candidate's previous scientific activity and scientific achievements on the basis of a CV and a cover letter (list of achievements attached, candidates may present up to three documented scientific achievements for assessment). <ul style="list-style-type: none">• each achievement to be assessed - 1-5 points	0-15
Assessment of the candidate's other documented activities on the basis of a maximum of three achievements (list of achievements attached). <ul style="list-style-type: none">• each achievement to be assessed - 1-2 points	0-5
Assessment of the initial research project proposal, with particular reference to: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• the ability to formulate the research objective and to present the research problem - 0-5 points• research idea and ability to propose a solution - 0-10 points• methodology appropriate to the chosen discipline - 0-3 points• knowledge of the state of the art in research, together with a basic bibliography - 0-2 points	0-20
Assessment of the interview, including: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• the candidate's knowledge and competencies relevant to research planning and appropriate to the chosen scientific discipline, - 0-25 points• elements of research methodology appropriate to the chosen discipline - 0-25 points	0-50
