Should the candidate present a greater number of achievements, the Chair of the Selection Panel will award points for the 3 highest-scoring achievements (if candidates do not provide additional documentation confirming these achievements). In the event that the sum of the 3 highest scoring achievements exceeds the maximum number for this element of the assessment, the maximum possible score will be awarded.

Documented publications accepted for publication are also taken into account. Publications in preparation, given without any confirmation of acceptance for publication, will not be taken into account.

Points for the remaining 3 documented achievements in the candidate's activity (max. 5 points total for all achievements):

- international scholarship or award 4 points
- national scholarship or award 2 points
- university or regional scholarship or award 1 point
- documented participation in the team of contractors of NCN, NPRH and other grants 2 points
- documented participation in the organisation of an international conference 2 points
- documented participation in the organisation of a national conference 1 point

- documented participation in the organisation of an exhibition 1 point
- documented work in student scientific association 1 point
- documented work in student government 1 point
- documented participation in scientific and organisational projects of the University (or its units), as well as participation in undertakings of social organisations 1 point
- documented cooperation with academic or other institutions (e.g. archives, libraries) 1 point
- documented membership in scientific associations 1 point
- pursuing a second major 1 point
- internships or long-term stays abroad or at home during studies 1 point
- sporting or artistic achievement 1 point
- participation in voluntary work 1 point
- documented participation in a language course 1 point

If a candidate presents more than one achievement, the Chair of the Selection Panel will award points for the 3 highest-scoring achievements. In the event that the sum of the 3 highest scoring achievements exceeds the maximum number for this element of the assessment, the maximum score will be awarded.
