

**Evaluation criteria for the candidate's scholarly and organisational activities**  
**Discipline: Political Science and Public Administration**

The selection committee will only take into account documents attesting to the event in question, and will not take into account statements without attestation

1. Grade for the diploma of master's studies or uniform master's studies:

**- maximum 10 points;**

- 3 = 1 point
- 3,5 = 3 points
- 4 = 6 points
- 4,5 = 8 points
- 5 = 10 points

2. Assessment of previous scientific activity and achievements, based on the CV and cover letter; the candidate may present up to three documented scientific achievements; **maximum 15 points;**

- a. scientific publications in scientific journals, collective works and journals of scientific circles - only published ones (texts required or copies of texts to be submitted with the ISBN number) - 5 points for each publication,
- b. scientific conferences with papers, communications, posters - 3 points for each conference

3. Other documented activity on the basis of a maximum of three achievements presented by the candidate; **maximum 5 points;**

- a. Participation in student scientific movement,
- b. national and international internships (exchange programmes, e.g. MOST, LLP-Erasmus, other scholarship, internships related to the field of study, specialisation - not applicable to the obligatory internships included in the study plan and curriculum)
- c. awards and distinctions for academic achievements and student activity,
- d. knowledge of foreign languages (certificates or certificates of language courses must be presented);

Points will be awarded according to the following rules:

- one achievement = 1 point
- two achievements = 3 points
- three achievements = 5 points

4. Result of the interview; the scope of the interview will include:

- a. the candidate's knowledge and competencies relevant to the planned research and appropriate to the chosen scientific discipline,

- b. elements of research methodology appropriate for the chosen discipline.

A **maximum of 50 points** can be obtained for the interview; the maximum duration of the interview is 30 minutes.

5. A preliminary research project proposal submitted, **maximum 20 points**, with particular emphasis on:
  - a. the ability to formulate the research objective and present the research problem;
  - b. novelty and originality of the research idea and ability to propose a solution;
  - c. the methodology appropriate to the discipline concerned;
  - d. knowledge of the state of the art of the research, together with a basic bibliography relevant to the objectives.
