1. Interview (0 – 50 points):

The interview should last approximately 30 minutes.

Assessment of answers must be commented upon. Suggested number of questions – 5

2. Assessment of the research project (0-20):

Number of points with comments

- 1) ability to formulate the research objective, research hypotheses and research problem: **(10 points)**
- 2) novelty and originality of the research idea and ability to propose ways to describe it: **(4 points)**
- 3) methodology (appropriate to the topic submitted): **(4 points)**
- 4) knowledge of the state of the art in research, together with a basic bibliography relevant to the objectives pursued: **(2 points)**

3. Candidate's scientific activity (0-15):

(The candidate may present a maximum of 3 best scientific achievements, to be assessed on the basis of a CV and a cover letter)

a) Publications

10 points – foreign-language publication in publishing houses, journals present in the ministerial list of publishing houses, journals or in the former lists of journals A, B, C or SCOPUS, ERIH

5 points – publication in publishing houses, journals present in the ministerial list of publishing houses, journals or in the former lists of journals A, B, C or SCOPUS, ERIH

2 points – other scientific publication

b) Active (with paper) participation in scientific conferences (max. **5 points**)

3 points – speech given in a foreign language at an international conference

2 points – speech given at a national conference

1 point – speech given at another scientific conference

c) Internships, research trips in Poland (maximum one internship is evaluated)

- Internships (MOST type) in the country - 1 point
- Research trips in the country - point for each two months

d) Traineeships and research visits (maximum of one traineeship is evaluated)

- Periods abroad (Erasmus type) - 2 points
- Research trips abroad - point for each month

e) Participation in grants and research projects (as at least contractor, maximum 10 points):

- international - 8 points
- national – 4 points
- local - 2 points

f) Prizes and awards of scientific character (maximum 3 points)

g) Other (maximum 2 points)

4. Candidate's other activities (0-5 points)

- a) work in scientific associations
- b) organisation of scientific conferences
- c) organisational prizes and distinctions awarded by the university
- d) popularisation activity
- e) activity in the field of culture
- f) artistic activity
- g) activity for the benefit of the local government
- h) other
