Criteria for the assessment of a candidate's achievements for studies in the Doctoral School of Humanities in the discipline of Arts Sciences (based on Resolution No. 65/2020/2021 of the Senate of Adam Mickiewicz University in Poznań of 25 January 2021 on the principles of recruitment to the Doctoral School of Adam Mickiewicz University, Poznań in the academic year 2021/2022).

<p>“The selection committee shall take into account:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) the grade awarded to the candidate upon completion of the second cycle studies or single cycle five year master’s studies, maximum 10 points”
<p>Number of points awarded for the diploma grade, respectively:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">very good – 10 points,good plus – 8 points,good – 6 points,satisfactory plus – 4 points,satisfactory – 2 points.
<p>“2) evaluation of the candidate's scientific activity and scientific achievements up to the date of the selection procedure on the basis of the candidate’s CV and a cover letter; the candidate presents for evaluation up to three documented scientific achievements (attached list of achievements); maximum 15 points;”</p>
<p>Specific requirements: documented achievements will be assessed, such as: scientific publications (3-5 points), participation in conferences (1-3 points), internships, scholarships, participation in grants (1-5 points), awards and distinctions for scientific achievements (1-5 points), completed studies in the second field (bachelor's degree – 3 points, master's degree - 5 points). If three achievements are not presented, the selection panel will choose them from among those listed in the CV having the candidate's best interests in mind.</p>
<p>“3) evaluation of the candidate's other documented activities, based on a maximum of three achievements presented by the candidate (list of achievements attached); maximum 5 points</p>
<p>Specific requirements: documented achievements will be assessed, such as: articles and other forms of popular science publications, ongoing studies in the second field of study, organisational and artistic activities related to the chosen scientific discipline, work in a student science group and others. In case three achievements are not presented, the selection panel will choose them from among those listed in the CV having the candidate’s best interests in mind.</p>
<p>“4) the result of the interview, with the scope of the interview including:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">a) the candidate's knowledge and competencies relevant to the planned research and appropriate to the chosen scientific discipline,b) elements of research methodology appropriate for the chosen discipline (50 points)
<p>“5) evaluation of the research project prepared for the admission (maximum 20 points), with</p>

particular emphasis on:

- a) the ability to formulate the research objective and present the research problem;
- b) research idea and the ability to propose a solution;
- c) methodology appropriate to the chosen discipline;
- d) knowledge of the state of research with a basic bibliography.”
