Detailed recruitment criteria to the Doctoral School of Humanities, Adam Mickiewicz University in the discipline of History in the academic year 2022/2023

A grade entered in the graduation diploma – second-cycle studies or uniform master’s studies	max 10 points
• very good	10 points
• good plus	8 points
• good	6 points
• satisfactory plus	4 points
• satisfactory	2 points

Scientific achievements (points for up to three documented achievements):¹	no more than 15 points total
• Author of a scientific monograph or edited text (more than 6 publisher’s sheets)	10 points
• Author of a compact scientific publication of less than 6 publisher’s sheets	8 points
• Editor of a scientific monograph	6 points
• Author of an article in a journal from the list of scientific journals published by the Ministry of Science and Higher Education and peer-reviewed materials from international conferences in the current version. Reviews will be credited with half the number of points per article.	6 points
• Author of an article in a scientific journal from outside the list of scientific journals and peer-reviewed proceedings from international conferences published by Ministry of Science and Higher Education in the current version. Reviews will be credited with half of the points per article.	4 points
• Author of a chapter in a scientific monograph	5 points
• Author of a compact popular science publication	3 points

• Author of a popular science article in a journal or on a website, excluding entries in social media	2 points
• Author of a chapter in a popular science monograph	2 points
• Award in a competition for the best BA or MA thesis	10 points
• Original own research project financed by external funding (Diamond Grant, Pearls of Science, etc.)	10 points
• Implementation of own research project financed by university funds (ID-UB and others)	5 points
• A paper read at an international scientific conference	5 points
• Poster presentation at an international scientific conference	4 points
• A paper read at a national scientific conference	4 points
• Poster presentation at a national scientific conference	3 points
• A paper read at a national/regional/university student or student-doctoral conference	2 points

IMPORTANT!

- In the evaluation of a candidate's scientific achievements, publications accepted for publication after obtaining positive reviews may also be taken into account, provided that the candidate submits a written certificate issued by an authorized person (president/director/editor/secretary of the publishing house - editor/editorial secretary of the journal) and sends a pdf file with the text of the publication in the version accepted for publication to the e-mail address indicated by the admission committee. This rule does not apply to popular science publications.
- If the candidate is not the sole author or editor of the publication, the points will be divided by the number of authors/editors.

Other achievements (points awarded for up to three documented achievements):²	no more than 5 points total
• National scholarship	4 points
• Regional scholarship	3 points
• University scholarship or academic performance award	2 points
• Participation in the team of contractors of past and ongoing NCN, NPRH and other grants	4 points

• Participation in the organization of an international conference	2 points
• Participation in the organization of a national conference	1 point
• Participation in the organization of an exhibition	1 point
• Involvement in student research club. In the event of serving on the board of the club the score is increased by 50%	2 points
• Participation in scientific and organizational projects of the University (or its units), as well as involvement in projects of scientific and cultural institutions and organizations (e.g. in the form of voluntary work)	2 points
• Membership of scientific, cultural and educational associations	2 points
• Second major studies	2 points
• Internships or long-term stays abroad or at home (e.g. under Erasmus, MOST or other programs) undertaken in the course of study	5 points
• Participation in a language course	1 point
