Detailed criteria for awarding points for scientific achievements in the recruitment procedure to the Doctoral School of Humanities in the discipline of Art Studies

Recruitment Committee for the Doctoral School for the discipline of Art Science, in accordance with § 10 of the Rules of admission to doctoral schools of the Adam Mickiewicz University in Poznań in the academic year 2023/2024, the document attached to Resolution 287/2022/2023 of the AMU Senate of January 30, 2023, adopts the following application evaluation criteria:

1. Interview (0-50 points)

The conversation will concern the issues of the discipline within a given field of study (history of art or musicology), the candidates' scientific interests, their knowledge in the declared scientific area, the issues of the proposed doctoral thesis and the methodological framework.

2. Evaluation of the research project (0-20 points):

- a) ability to formulate the research objective, research hypotheses and research problem (0-10 points)
- b) originality and novelty of the idea and research perspective (0-5 points)
- c) methodological awareness, choice of research method, knowledge of the state of the art in research (0-5 points)

3. The candidate's scientific activity (0-15 points)

(The candidate can indicate a maximum of 3 scientific achievements, evaluated on the basis of the documents submitted)

- a) publications
- author's monograph or publication in journals from the ministerial list 100 200 points (10 points)
- publication in journals from the ministerial list 20-70 points (7 points)
- publication in collective works in publishing houses from the ministerial list (5 points)
- other scientific publication (2 points).
- b) active participation (with a paper) in scientific conferences
- speech delivered at an international conference (3 points)
- presentation at a national conference (2 points)
- presentation at another scientific conference (1 point)
- c) Internship/research visits
- MOST, national research visits (1 point)
- foreign placements/research visits (2 points)
- d) participation in grants and research projects
- international: as leader 7 points, as contractor 5 points
- national: as manager (fe. "Diamond Grant") 5 points, as contractor 3 point.
- e) scientific awards and distinctions, e.g. a medal for academic achievements (2 points)
- a) additional bachelor's (1 point) and master's degree diplomas (2 points)
- b) other achievements (1-2 points)

- 4. Other activity of the candidate, e.g. work in scientific circles/clubs, organization of scientific conferences, university prizes and distinctions of an organizational nature, outreach activity, activity in the field of culture, artistic activity (0-5 points)
- 5. Grade entered in the graduation diploma (0-10 points)
 - satisfactory 0 points
 - satisfactory plus 2 points
 - good 5 points
 - good plus 8 points
 - very good 10 points
