"Within the framework of academic mobility October 22-28, 2023 by the invitation of my Polish colleagues, I had the opportunity to represent Kherson State University by participating in the work of the International Summer School "Educational Management and Creating New Study Offer" based on Adam Mickiewicz University (Poznan, Poland), which took place within the framework of the project "UNIWERSYTET JUTRAII - POWR.03.05.00-00-Z303/18".

Current issues, related to the improvement of the quality of the educational process, the implementation of educational programs, and quality assurance of higher education were discussed together with the delegates from 28 universities - partners of Ukraine with Polish colleagues. All this is a key to the future development of Ukraine and an important step in establishing communication and implementing the exchange of experience with foreign partners.

During the visit, I got acquainted with the institutional accreditation procedure and discussed the issue of internal quality assurance of education with the vice-rector of educational and training work of the Adam Mickiewicz University, Yoanna Vujchik. Director Marek Sobchak introduced the features of the activity of the educational support centre to the participants of the International Summer School. Based on a comparative analysis of the higher education systems of Poland and Ukraine, Dr. Marcyn Dokovich outlined the potential barriers that appear in the process of implementing programs of double diplomas and considered ways to overcome them together with his colleagues,

There was an exchange of views on issues of educational management, specifics of implementation and accreditation of educational programs during round tables. Further Polish-Ukrainian cooperation in the implementation of joint proposals to expand the list of optional disciplines for applicants in the sphere of non-formal education (courses and training) was discussed with colleagues. There were lectures conducted by scientific and pedagogical staff of the partner university and joint international conferences were organized.
