MUST BE ADMITTED TO OUR INSTITUTION IN ORDER TO RECEIVE THE DS-2019 FORM TO APPLY FOR THEIR VISA. THE ORIGINAL DS-2019 FORM IS REQUIRED IN ORDER TO START THE VISA APPLICATION PROCESS. FEE CAN VARY DEPENDING ON THE COUNTRY.



ON-CAMPUS HOUSING
