

**Detailed criteria for awarding points in the admission procedure to the Doctoral School
of Adam Mickiewicz University**

in the discipline of theological sciences

in the academic year 2021/2022

1. Grade from the diploma of master's studies or uniform master's studies (maximum 10 points):

- very good (5.0) – 10 points
- good plus (4.5) – 6 points
- good (4.0) – 2 points
- satisfactory plus (3.5) – 1 point

(in accordance with the rules for obtaining the degree of Doctor of Theological Sciences, the presentation of a diploma in theology is required)

2. Academic achievements on the basis of a CV (maximum three documented achievements, maximum 15 points)

- authorship/co-authorship of a scientific publication not related to the content of the diploma thesis (scientific article, monograph, chapter in a monograph) – 5 points
- participation in research projects of scientific institutions – 5 points
- scientific paper read at an international conference – 5 points, at a national conference – 4 points

3. Candidate's other documented activities (maximum three documented achievements, maximum 5 points)

- awards and distinctions for scientific activity (awarded by the Dean, Rector, scientific society or the Minister) – 3 points
- internship in scientific institutions – 3 points
- participation in the organisation of a scientific conference – 2 points
- popularisation of science in mass media or other popularising activity in the field of theological sciences – 2 points.
- activity aimed at cooperation with the social and economic environment – 2 points

4. Interview (maximum duration 30 minutes, maximum 50 points)

- candidate's knowledge and competencies relevant to the research to be undertaken and appropriate to the discipline of theological sciences – 0-40 points
- elements of research methodology appropriate for the discipline of theological sciences – 0-10 points

5. Research project (maximum 20 points)

- ability to formulate the research objective and present the research problem (0-5 points)
- novelty and originality of the research project and ability to propose a solution (0-5 points)
- correctness of the methodology appropriate to the discipline of theological sciences (0-5 points)
- knowledge of the state of research and bibliography relevant to the presented research objective (0-5 points)
