**Detailed criteria for awarding points for scientific achievements in the recruitment procedure to the Doctoral School of Social Sciences in the discipline of pedagogy in the academic year 2023/2024**

• Good plus	6 points

<b>Academic achievements (points for up to three recorded achievements):<sup>1</sup></b>	<b>max 15 points</b>
1. Publications in peer-reviewed journals	5 points
2. Active participation in conferences (paper)	5 points
3. Scientific scholarships (e.g. scholarship of Adam Mickiewicz University Foundation, scholarship of dr Jan Kulczyk and other scientific scholarships)	5 points
4. Edited book or monograph or chapter in monograph	5 points
5. Participation in research projects financed by the Ministry of Science and Higher Education, NCBiR, non-governmental organizations	5 points

1. Work in academic circles/clubs	2 points
2. Delivering training or workshops	1 point
3. Voluntary work	1 point
4. Participation in organizational committees of conferences, scientific seminars	1 point
5. Popular science publications	2 points
