the Doctoral School of Humanities for the academic year 2025/2026

Scientific discipline:  
Ethnology and Cultural Anthropology

DIPLOMA GRADE	
A candidate may receive either 0 or 5 points	
A minimum "very good" grade (or equivalent) on a second-degree diploma or a uniform master's degree diploma:	5 points
Applying for admission to the doctoral school based on outstanding scientific achievements (e.g., receiving a grant under the "Pearls of Science" competition):	5 points
In all other cases:	0 points

SCIENTIFIC ACHIEVEMENTS	
A maximum of three documented achievements will be evaluated The candidate can receive up to 20 points in total

Author of a foreign-language publication in publishing houses/journals from the ministerial list or from the former lists of journals A, B, C, SCOPUS, ERICH	10 points
Participation as <i>corresponding author</i> in a multi-author foreign-language publication in publishing houses/journals from the ministerial list or from the former lists of journals A, B, C, SCOPUS, ERICH	9 points
Co-author of a foreign-language publication in publishing houses/journals from the ministerial list or from the former lists of journals A, B, C, SCOPUS, ERICH	8 points
Participation in a multi-author foreign-language publication in publishing houses/journals from the ministerial list or from the former lists of journals A, B, C, SCOPUS, ERICH	7 points

Participation as the main presenter (or editor) in a multi-author publication in Polish in publishing houses/journals from the ministerial list or from the former lists of journals A, B, C, SCOPUS, ERICH	5 points

Elements of research methodology appropriate to the chosen discipline (i.e. ethnology and cultural anthropology):	0 - 15 points

<b>RESEARCH PROJECT<sup>1</sup></b>	
<b>A candidate can receive a maximum of 20 points</b>	
Ability to formulate the research objective and present the research problem:	0 - 4 points
Originality of the research idea and selection of appropriate problem-solving methods:	0 - 4 points
Methodology appropriate to the chosen discipline (i.e. ethnology and cultural anthropology):	0 - 4 points
Knowledge of existing research, supported by a basic bibliography:	0 - 4 points
Significance of the project for the development of the chosen discipline (i.e. ethnology and cultural anthropology):	0 - 4 points
