- 1. progress in the preparation of the doctoral dissertation;
- 2. research activity, including scientific publications, conference presentations and grant applications;

The Council waives the specification of the above elements in terms of quantitative criteria.

The mid-term evaluation conducted by the Evaluation Committee is based on:

- 1. a narrative summary prepared by the doctoral student;
- 2. documentation confirming the activity of the doctoral student and the opinion of the supervisor or supervisors;
- 3. an interview with the doctoral student.
