- 1) Seminars on selected fundamental issues in linguistics and literary studies that transcend disciplines and fields, serving to broaden erudition and scholarly imagination, as well as to maintain contact with the most important and recent developments in science/humanities/world philology.

- 5) Annual presentation of the doctoral students' research interests and achievements in the form of a scientific conference, a series of lectures or panels, a self-study programme, open thematic workshops, a summer school (or another, indicated by the director of the school) with the participation of eminent scientists and supervisors.
- 6) Subjects chosen by the doctoral student in agreement with the supervisor from the offer of Doctoral Schools of Adam Mickiewicz University and particular faculties.
