V. VISA INFORMATION		
Type of visa	- Any students studying long-term in Vietnam must obtain a student visa (DH) It is impossible to convert tourist visa into student visa after entering Vietnam.	

Process	 HUFLIT submits the necessary documents to the Vietnam Immigration Department in Ho Chi Minh City. The visa pre-approval is usually issued after 7 working days. HUFLIT will send a copy of the visa pre-approval to you via email. Please bring the following documents to the Vietnam Embassy or Vietnam Consulate General in your area (based on your choice in the online application form) to get the visa: Passport with validity of at least 6 months; Pre-approval confirmation (Printed on an A4-size-paper); Visa application form (following the officials' guidance at the Vietnam Embassy/Vietnam Consulate General). Visa application fee (submit at Vietnam Embassy/ Vietnam Consulate General). The fee may vary in different countries.

Airport pick up	 HUFLIT will provide <i>free</i> pick-up services for exchange students. The preferable time is from 8:00 to 16:00 (GMT+7) on weekdays. Kindly inform the HUFLIT Coordinator about your arrival for better preparation. 			
Buddy program	For international students who are not familiar with the lifestyle and culture of Vietnam, studying at HUFLIT can be a daunting experience; that's why HUFLIT offers the Buddy Program, in which new international students will be paired up with current HUFLIT students (Buddies) who will provide a helping hand to the newcomers at HUFLIT by providing linguistics support, cultural guidance and information about life at HUFLIT.			
VII. EXPENSES				
	Tuition fee and admission fee shall be waived for exchange students .			
Tuition	 International students but not exchange students shall pay the same tuition and admission fees as regular HUFLIT students. The admission fee is \$28, while the tuition fee is counted by credits with \$40 - \$60/credit. 			
Textbooks	\$25 - \$50/semester (estimated)			
Food	\$1.5 - \$3/casual meal (estimated)			
Accommodation (apply for students who do not get the scholarship in part IV)	 Students shall be supported in finding suitable accommodation near the campus (\$250 - \$300/month), including a bed, internet, private bathroom, air conditioner, and refrigerator. A deposit is often required as a form of security and is refundable at the end of the tenancy, provided there are no damages or outstanding payments. 			

	 Students should bring cash or an ATM card (which can withdraw or transfer money) to pay the rental fee. Students should stay in a hotel while finding suitable rental rooms/apartments. Students can find the accommodation themselves but should report the address to the HUFLIT Coordinator to be supported and protected when necessary. Always remember to make a contract with the landlord.
Transportation	\$50/month
Mobile phone bill	\$5
Insurance	It is not compulsory to purchase Vietnamese insurance, but it is highly recommended in case of emergency. Therefore, students should buy the insurance that you can use in Vietnam in your home country.
