 - 5) Upload a Letter of Recommendation from an Academic Source
 - 6) Upload Original Sealed Transcript from Currently Enrolled University
 - 7) Upload a Copy of the Passport Information Page
 - 8) Upload ID Photo*
 - * The background of ID photo must be white and only JPG image file can be uploaded.
