Nomination deadline	Partner universities should submit the nomination form by email. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ For Spring 2026: October 31<sup>st</sup>, 2025</li> <li>▪ For Fall 2026: April 28<sup>th</sup>, 2026</li> </ul>

## Costs

Tuition

Exchange students pay tuition to their home institutions and CWNU tuition is waived.

If exchange students wish to attend the Korean Language School (KLS), they need to pay the discounted KLS tuition directly to CWNU: 800,000won

Other costs

Meal and food: Approximately 3,000~5,000KRW/meal in student cafeteria, and 5,000~15,000KRW/meal in off-campus restaurant

Settlement fee (1<sup>st</sup> month): Approximately 200,000~300,000KRW including textbooks, alien card application, health checkup, daily supplies, etc.

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**Visa requirements**

Exchange students need to obtain D-2-6 visa to study at CWNU.

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**Insurance requirement**

All exchange students are automatically signed up for National Health Care Insurance after they receive Alien Registration Card. Students can have overseas travel insurance from their home country until they are signed into National Health Care Insurance.

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**Buddy program**

Before coming to CWNU, they can directly contact International Affairs and Education office when students have any inquiries about exchange program. Yet, if any students who are interested in studying at Changwon National University want to learn more about real student life, they can always get some useful tips from International Students Council (ISC).

Students will get contact from their buddies two weeks before the semester starts.
