Raport

A summer school organised by the Faculty of Psychology and Cognitive Science, 'Psychology of Reasoning: Theory, Practice, and Applications' was held from 12-19 May 2023. The school, funded by The National Centre for Research and Development, was designed as one of 30 week-long summer schools hosted by AMU.

The core programme of the school included lectures and exercises on how to test intelligence, competence in conducting various types of reasoning, and the accession of data on how test subjects solve tasks.










Individuals participating in the school prepared and conducted an eye-tracking experiment using Raven's matrix test boards in the standard version. The classes were led, by Dr Agnieszk Nowik, Dr Anna Stoyatska, Dr Maciej Raś, Prof. UAM Dr Mariusz Urbański, Klaudia Żwawiak.



The school's programme was anchored by workshops conducted by Linda Papitchenko and Dr Monika Zielona-Jenek. Their objective was to support group integration and involvement in learning in the summer school setting and at the end of the workshop, to summarise the experiences and their inclusion in the plans for further education at their home universities.









In addition, the group attended the Poznań Cognitive Science
Forum held simultaneously at the faculty and an evening meeting
of the Cognitive Science Students and Alumni Association. They
visited the Adam Mickiewicz University Botanical Garden and
Ostrów Tumski. In addition, they participated in a session filled with
singing together with a group of female psychologists who are
friends of the faculty. On 16 May, the participants hosted a
Ukrainian evening in Debina Palace.
