- * problems: protection of intellectual property, copyright law, law on higher education, publishing ethics and reliability in academic activity, knowledge transfer and commercialisation of research results; popularisation of science, etc.
- ** classes developing professional skills, preparing the doctoral student for work of a research or research and development nature (raising funds for research, presentation of research results, elements of bibliometrics, preparation of scientific publications, etc.).
- *** working in a team and research group management, interpersonal communication, intercultural competences, decision-making, career planning and time management, etc. ¹⁾ in the case of doctoral students pursuing "doktorat wdrożeniowy" (Industrial Doctoral Programme), the module of classes may be conducted in an enterprise and credited by the director of the Doctoral School on the basis of a detailed report of the entrepreneur with an indication of the accomplished educational results.

¹⁾ In the case of doctoral students pursuing "doktorat wdrożeniowy" (Industrial Doctoral Programme), the module taught may be implemented in an enterprise and credited by the director of the Doctoral School on the basis of a detailed report from the enterprise indicating the educational results achieved.

³⁾ Total of 80 hours, 20 hours in each academic year from the 2nd to the 8th semester as a part of supervisor's control over the implementation of the Individual Research Plan - appointments set by the supervisor after agreeing with the PhD student

Individual disciplines/faculties provide detailed guidelines applying to:

1. **Interdisciplinary scientific seminar** – all scientific seminars conducted within the disciplines and of an interdisciplinary nature – seminars offered by individual departments, seminars offered by individual faculties, etc., as well as seminars chosen by the Supervisor. Completion of a seminar is credited by the Supervisor. In the case of foreign PhD students, the seminar may be organized within the Doctoral School of Social Sciences and taught in English
2. **Academic didactics** – (1 x 15 hours) – also in English.
3. **Methodology of scientific research** – each discipline/faculty may nominate/designate one person to teach a methodology course in their own discipline. It is possible to designate one person to teach the methodology course in the entire school (2 x 10 hours) - also in English.
4. **Researcher's workshop** – each discipline/department may nominate/designate one person to teach the workshop in their own discipline (1 x 30 hours) - also in English. The course may be taught to all doctoral students.
5. **Specific nature of work in the discipline** each discipline/faculty may nominate/designate one teacher 1 x 15 hours.
6. **Soft skills workshops** – the same workshop(s) held for the entire school, following approval of the Council (1 x 15 hours) – also in English.
7. **Specialist lectures** – each discipline/faculty may nominate/designate from two to three lecturers each year (2 x 15 hours), including one teaching in English.
8. **Work experience** – teaching by doctoral students from the 3rd to the 8th semester - not more than 150 hours of teaching or participating in the teaching of courses amounting to not more than 60 teaching hours per year.
9. **Interdisciplinary block of courses** – each discipline/faculty may nominate/designate 3 teachers, of whom one teaching in English (3 x 15 hours)
