Insurance

Health insurance is required for all students. It is required that this insurance includes COVID-19 coverage. Students have to provide proof of insurance prior to their arrival in Mexico or purchase insurance at CETYS upon arrival.

Student visa

CETYS will provide assistance, when required, in securing visas for incoming and outbound mobility participants.

Arrival information

Airport of the pickup will be in the cities of Mexicali or Tijuana in Mexico. In the case of the United States, it will be at the San Diego Airport. The service is free of charge and will be provided by the university.

Housing and Living Expenses

There are no dormitories, facilities at CETYS. The international office will provide a list of options; however the students are free to select their own housing options.

- Renting with others students USD \$250-\$300 plus utilities.
- Meals per day USD \$20
- Lunch at University Cafeteria USD \$5
- Bus tickets USD \$0.70
- Estimated costs per month: USD \$600 (500-550 Euros).

Buddy Program

Located at the Ensenada International Campus the "Buddy Program" is coordinated by a group of CETYS students that helps international students, providing cultural, recreational and integration activities. All international students that will spend theirsemester at the Ensenada Campus will be supported by the Buddy Program since their arrival.
