Exchange students can reserve accommodation by submitting 'Housing Application Form' along with their exchange student application materials.

For exchange students from universities with dormitory fee waiver agreements with Gachon University, the waiver applies to 'Triple Rooms'. Students can opt for a 'Twin Room' but will incur the corresponding fee difference.



Dormitory fee for paying exchange students are charged based on the assigned room type and length of stay, aligned with the student exchange program length and academic schedules.

- 1 If you wish to stay longer than the fixed dates, please contact the dorm office. Dormitory fees are calculated on a weekly basis.
- If you move out of the dormitory during a period other than the regular move-out period, a deduction equivalent to two weeks' rent may apply.

Deposit

The deposit refund will NOT be processed AUTOMATICALLY.

To request a refund, follow these steps:

- 1 Collect the deposit refund application form from the dorm office.
- 2 Apply for the deposit refund at least one month before your check-out.
- 3 The deposit will be wired to your Korean bank account.



3. Information

Bedding

The dormitory does not provide bedding; you need to bring or purchase one yourself. (Only mattress and its cover are provided.)

Cafeteria & Meal Ticket

Cafeteria is located in Dormitory 3. Meals are not included in the dorm fees, so students must purchase meal tickets. (For 2024, meal coupons can be purchased at the cafeteria for $5,000 \sim 5,500$ KRW per meal)

Convenience store

The dormitory convenience store is located on the B1 floor, Dormitory 2.

Use of Telephone in a room

Each room is equipped with a phone for receiving calls, including international calls. Inquire about your room phone number from the dorm office.

Wireless Internet

Every room has a wireless router for Wi-Fi service, and free Wi-Fi service is available in most campus buildings.

Note

- 1 The requested room type may be subject to change based on dormitory availability. Triple rooms are equipped with bunk beds, potentially limiting personal space.
- 2 Public facilities may not be sufficient. For example, students must apply for fridge space on a first-come, first-served basis.)



<Dormitory Rules>

- 1 Smoking and bringing alcohol into the dormitory are strictly prohibited, with expulsion as the penalty for violations.one yourself. (Only mattress and its cover are provided.)
- 2 Wearing shoes or slippers inside rooms is not allowed.
- 3 Touching other student's items is strictly forbidden.
- 4 Students must ask to the dorm office before moving rooms.
- 5 Violence or harassment in any form will not be tolerated.
- The dormitory is closed from 1 am to 5 am; students cannot enter or leave during this time.
- Visiting other students' rooms after 11 pm or any activity that disrupts study or rest time is strictly prohibited.
- 8 Electric appliances are not allowed in rooms due to fire risk. (Must be allowed by the dorm office in advance.)
- 9 Students are responsible for keeping their rooms clean, with inspections conducted at least once a month.
- 10 Kitchen and dining areas must be cleaned after each use.
- III Important notices must be checked on the notice board on each floor.
- 12 Cooking in rooms is strictly PROHIBITED
