General Requirements

- Currently enrolled as a full-time student pursuing an undergraduate degree; Student who has a Master's degree may apply, but courses are only offered at an undergraduate level
- Nominated by the home institution
- Good academic standing (preferred above 2.5 out of 4.5 GPA Scale)
- B1 ~ B2 levels of English proficiency (Language test score is not required)
- An open mind to a new culture, Christianity, and willingness to follow the Handong culture & Honor Code

Semester Structure

- Course Credits are based on the amount of teaching hours. One course is normally 3 credits which is 40 hours per semester.
- Most courses are 3 credits per a course (lectures, quizzes, midterm and final).
- Normally, 3 credits in HGU corresponds to 5~6 ECTS in European Higher Education.

Health Insurance

- All international students are automatically registered with Korean government insurance to cover the costs of treatment for injury and sickness in Korea. (Not a way of reimbursement, but a way of reduction of the medical fee, as Korean citizenship).
- For the reimbursement of medical fees, students have the option to register for private insurance when arrive at Handong Global University.

Admission Process

1. Nomination email or form should be submitted by Home institution
 - Include Student Name, Birth of Date, Gender, Email address
 - Exchange Program Manager (exchange@handong.edu)
2. HGU directly sends the application guidelines to students
 - Requirements
 - Transcripts of Academic Records (Entire semester)
 - Valid Passport Copy (Details page)
 - Recommendation Letter (form provided)
 - Handong Honor Pledge
 - 1 Head-Shoulder Photo
3. Students get feedback, Visa Documents, and information through Email.

Course Registration

- Online Course Registration: January (Spring semester), July (Fall semester)
- Student will receive a link and guideline by email to register for courses.

Visa

- Students entering Korea to study need to obtain a Student Visa (D-2) from a Korean embassy/consulate in their country.
- A visa packet and information from HGU will be sent to the student's home institution after the student is accepted.

Dormitory

- Koreans and International students will share a room (4 students)
- Furniture include beds, desks, bookshelves, closets are provided in each room
- Facilities: shower stalls, laundry room, lounge, small kitchen
- Free Wi-Fi on Campus
