PROGRAM FOR EXCHANGE STUDENTS

The Japanese Language and Culture Program (JLCP) offers half- or full-year courses for students seeking to develop their Japanese language skills. International students* are accepted twice a year, in April and September, with 80-90 students enrolling each semester. *Currently, only students from partner institutions are accepted.

*Language and other conditions will apply.

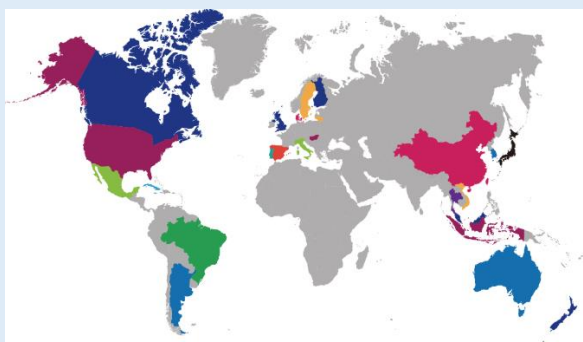
*JLCP regular courses are prioritized.

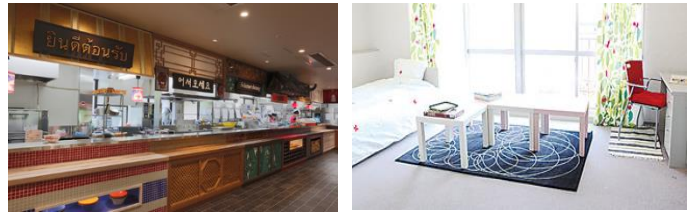
FACILITIES
