DIPLOMA GRADE	
<b>In this category the candidate may receive maximum 3 points</b> In the absence of a diploma grade, the average grade from the course of study is taken into account.

<b>The candidate shall indicate a maximum of 3 documented scientific achievements for evaluation. They may receive no more than 22 points in total.</b>		
N.1	Publications in peer-reviewed journals	7 points
N.2	Active participation in conferences (paper)	6 points
N.3	Scientific scholarships (e.g. scholarship of Adam Mickiewicz University Foundation, scholarship of dr. Jan Kulczyk and others of a scientific nature)	7 points
N.4	Edited book or author's monograph or chapter in a monograph	6 points
N.5	Participation in research projects	7 points

OTHER ACTIVITIES OF THE CANDIDATE		
<b>The candidate shall indicate a maximum of 3 documented achievements for evaluation. They may receive no more than 5 points in total.</b>		
I.1	Activities in science clubs	2 points
I.2	Conducting training courses or workshops	1 point
I.3	Participation in organizing committees of conferences, scientific seminars	3 points
I.4	Popular science publications	2 points

RESEARCH PROJECT	
The candidate may receive a maximum of 20 points	
Ability to formulate the research objective and present the research problem	0 – 4 points
Originality of the research idea and selection of appropriate problem-solving methods	0 – 3 points
Methodology appropriate to the chosen discipline	0 – 4 points
Knowledge of existing research, supported by a basic bibliography	0 – 4 points
Significance of the project for the development of the chosen discipline	0 – 4 points
Risk analysis of research tasks	0 – 1 points

The candidate may receive a maximum of 50 points	
Knowledge and competencies appropriate to the chosen discipline	0 – 25 points
Elements of research methodology appropriate to the chosen discipline	0 – 25 points
