<b>STUDENT DORMITORY</b>	<p>ENU offers all exchange students the opportunity to stay in a student dormitory free of charge. Students do not need to register individually for housing — the International Office coordinators submit the accommodation lists directly to the dormitory administration.</p>
<b>REQUIRED DOCUMENTS</b>	<p><b>To be accommodated, you must bring the following documents:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Passport</li> <li>• Photocopy of your passport</li> <li>• Two photos (size 3x4 cm)</li> <li>• One document binder</li> <li>• Two sheet protectors</li> <li>• Chest X-ray (fluorography)</li> <li>• Medical certificate No. 075 (This should be obtained after arrival, within the first or second day, at Abdugalimov Clinic, located at 6/7 Abylaihana <i>NB! Make sure to bring your fluorography (Chest X-ray) and passport to the clinic.</i></li> </ul>
<h2>VISA</h2>	
<b>FOR STUDENTS REQUIRING VISA</b>	<p>To apply for a visa at the Embassy of Kazakhstan, students need an official invitation letter issued by the Migration Service of Kazakhstan. The application to the Migration Service is submitted by ENU, not by the student. The preparation of this document takes <b>one month</b>.</p>
<b>FOR STUDENTS NOT REQUIRING VISA</b>  <b>(Russia, Belarus, Kyrgyzstan, Armenia, Uzbekistan, Tajikistan, Azerbaijan)</b>	<p>Citizens of the Eurasian Economic Union (EAEU) countries do not need a visa to study in Kazakhstan. However, they are required to obtain a Temporary Residence Permit (TRP / ПБП). The application for a Temporary Residence Permit is processed through the International Office of ENU upon arrival. Students will be guided by the coordinators throughout the procedure.</p>
