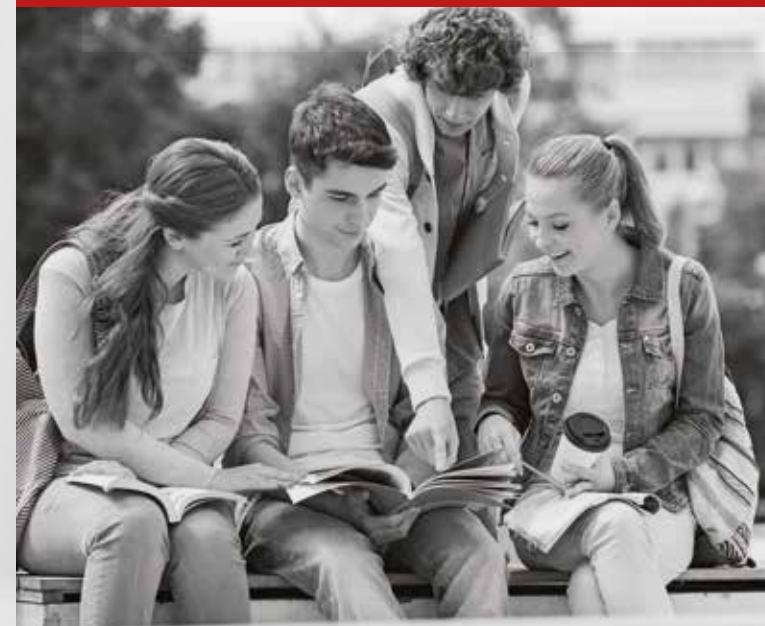

St Petersburg University

St Petersburg University is one of the leading and highest-ranked universities in Russia included in top 2% universities in the world.

In the framework of non-degree (exchange and free mover) programmes a student can spend one or two semesters at the University taking courses or conducting research.

Non-degree programmes are available on: tuition-free (exchange) basis to the students of the University's partner universities; or on fee-paying (free mover) basis to all applicants.

Non-degree students can: take University courses up to 30 ECTS per semester at undergraduate (Bachelor) and graduate (Master) levels; or conduct research under the supervision of a University scientific advisor at graduate (Master) and postgraduate (PhD) levels.

St Petersburg University warmly welcomes students from all over the world.

Application procedure and requirements

Application guidelines and the list of required documents can be found on the webpage <http://ifea.spbu.ru/en/sep>

Exchange students can be enrolled at the University only if in their chosen language of instruction (Russian or English) their level is confirmed as B2 or higher in accordance with the European Language Level Self-Assessment Grid (CEFR).

Exception is made for the students who apply for the full-time Russian language course for foreign students. It is available for students with any level of Russian language proficiency (the level of English must be B1 or higher).

Deadlines for nomination and application:

Autumn semester and full year: 1 May

Spring semester: 10 October

Short-term research programmes for students: two months before the planned start of mobility

Russian Language Courses

Exchange students from partner universities can optionally attend a free Russian language course (eight academic hours per week, eight ECTS per semester) during the whole exchange period supplementary to their major courses.

There is also an opportunity to apply for full-time Russian language courses (20 academic hours per week, 30 ECTS per semester) to improve your language proficiency. **Exchange students with any level of Russian language proficiency can apply for a full-time Russian language course.**
