IV. VISA INFORMATION				
	- Any prospective students studying long-term in Vietnam must obtain a			
	student visa.			
Type of visa	- It is unable to convert a tourist visa into a student visa after you enter			
	the Vietnam border.			
	- HUFLIT will help international students obtain visa pre-approval before			
	their departure to Vietnam			
	- HUFLIT submits the necessary documents to the Vietnam Immigration			
	Department in Ho Chi Minh City (VID-HCMC). The visa pre-approval is			
	usually issued after 7 working days.			
	- VID-HCMC will fax a copy of visa pre-approval to the nearest Vietnam			
	Embassy or Vietnam Consulate General in your home country (based on			
	your choice as written in the online application form).			
	- You will receive a copy of the visa pre-approval from HUFLIT via email.			
Process	Please bring the following documents to the Vietnam Embassy or			
	Vietnam Consulate General in your area to get the visa:			
	+ Passport with validity of at least 6 months;			
	+ Pre-approval confirmation (Printed on an A4-size-paper);			
	+ Visa Application Forms (following the officials' guidance at the			
	Vietnam Embassy/Vietnam Consulate General).			
	+ Visa application fees (submit at Vietnam Embassy/ Vietnam			
	Consulate General). The fee may vary according to different Vietnam			
	Embassies in different countries.

Airport pick up	- HUFLIT will provide free pick-up services for exchange students .	
	- The preferable time is from 8:00 to 16:00 (GMT+7) on weekdays. Kindly	
	inform the HUFLIT Coordinator about your arrival for better preparation.	
Buddy program	For international students who are not familiar with the lifestyle and culture	
	of Vietnam, studying at HUFLIT can be a daunting experience; that's why	
	HUFLIT offers the Buddy Program, in which new international students will	
	be paired up with current HUFLIT students (Buddies) who will provide a	
	helping hand to the newcomers at HUFLIT by providing linguistics	
	support, cultural guidance and information about life at HUFLIT.	
	- Tuition fees and admission fees shall be waived for exchange students .	
	- International students but not exchange students shall pay the same	
Tuition fee	tuition and admission fees as regular HUFLIT students	
	- The admission fee is \$28, while the tuition fee is counted by credits with	
	\$40 - \$60/credit.	
Textbooks	\$25 - \$50/ semester (estimated)	
Food	\$1.5 - \$3/ casual meal (estimated)	
	- International students shall be supported in finding suitable	
	accommodation near the campus (\$200 - \$250 /month), including a bed,	
	internet, private bathroom, air conditioner, and refrigerator.	
Accommodation	- Students should stay in a hotel while finding suitable rental	
	rooms/apartments.	
	- Students are recommended to find the accommodation themselves.	
	Still, they should report the address to the HUFLIT Coordinator to be	
	supported and protected when necessary.	
	- If students find the accommodation themselves, always remember to make	
	a contract with the owner. The owner usually requires a deposit of 1 month.	
Insurance	It is not compulsory to purchase Vietnamese insurance, but it is highly	
	recommended in case of emergency.
